For each senior, add \$100 for graduation fees.

What does tuition include?

- An athletic activity card
- A yearbook
- All textbooks (AP Classes excluded)
- Class dues

What does tuition not include?

- Meals, uniforms, and instructional supplies are not included.
- Workbook and laboratory fees as required by certain courses
- After-school care (3-5:15 PM) fees are not included.
- Tuition for Dual Enrollment classes offered through Co-Lin

What about tuition refunds?

- If a student withdraws prior to the first day of school as designated on the school calendar but after tuition has been paid, 75% of tuition will be refunded.
- If a student withdraws after attending one or more days of school, no refund will be made.

The Finance Committee and the School Advisory Council have set and approved the Cathedral School tuition rates for the 2020-2021 school year.

An increase in the cost for employee health insurance has raised our expenses significantly for the 2020-2021 school year. A modest increase in teacher salary has also added to our expenses.

The purpose of the increase in tuition is two-fold. One portion of the increase is targeted to raise teacher salary. One goal of the School Advisory Council is to narrow the gap between the Cathedral teachers' salary scale and the State salary scale. This will greatly help with the recruitment and retention of quality teachers.

The second portion of the increase is to cover the major increase in the cost of employee health insurance. Our rates have increased by 15%, or \$160,680 for this coming school year.
