MacBook Air Care

MacBook Air

Handle device with care. Use on a flat, stable surface. Do not put heavy books on device in backpack. Do not lean on device as this can break the screen. Never expose device to extreme hot or cold temperatures. Do not store device in vehicle for extended periods of time or leave in visible sight. The device must remain free of any writing, drawings, labels, stickers, etc. and should be kept in the school-issued protective case at all times. Carry securely at all times.

Protective Case

The case must be purchased from VCS. It protects device from scratches during normal use and is to be used at all times. The case is personal property and may be decorated or personalized with appropriate writing/stickers.

Backpack (additional padded sleeve highly recommended even if backpack has a laptop compartment)

Handle backpack or padded sleeve with device with care. Do not drop, throw, or toss backpack with device on floor or against wall. Do not store drinks in backpack with device. Screen damage can occur if stuffed tightly with books and other objects in a backpack.

Screen Care

Keep device away from food and drinks. Avoid touching the screen with sharp objects such as pens and pencils. Do not place heavy objects on device and never insert or place any object between screen and keyboard when closing. To clean the screen, use a microfiber cloth. Do not use any cleaners or solvents as these will damage the screen.

Battery

Students are responsible for recharging device so it is fully charged for school each day. There are no charging stations at the school.

Headphones/Earbuds

Students are responsible for bringing own headphones/earbuds to school each day. The cost of headphones/earbuds should not exceed \$100.

Monitoring/Supervision

Do not leave device unattended in an unlocked classroom or during extracurricular activities. Do not allow classmates, friends, or family members to borrow or use device. Do not share passwords. Do not attempt to "jailbreak" or modify device, or attempt to install or download inappropriate or illegal software or applications. Parents are responsible for web activity off campus.
