#### **Ms. Gray.....**

**\*Kindergarten Parents, we are hiring an additional kindergarten teacher. Friday, we conducted teacher interviews for the kindergarten position. We had 3 interviews. 5 are scheduled for Monday. The panel included: Ms Gray (Principal), Charles Bell (School Administrative Assistant/classified), Vip Hongthong (parent), Teresa Luu (parent), Cheryl**



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Clark (teacher/UTLA chapter chair), Tamara Metken (Categorical Program Advisor), Melissa Kishner (Instructional Coach). We expect to make a final decision/selection on Tuesday. In the meantime, a pool teacher will substitute for the position, starting Monday, 9/24. She will work with staff to get the classroom ready for the new class on Monday. Teachers are working to determine which students will go to the new class. As you know, once a teacher is selected, he or she must go through a process before starting. That process should be relatively short as these applicants are already working for LAUSD, are pool teachers or substitutes and in a couple of cases, are teaching at other schools and are wanting to transfer to be closer to home.

Ms. Clark has 14 TK's and 14 K's. She will retain her 14 TK's and will get 6-7 K's from the other teachers who have had very little to no pre-school or a pre-school that was not academic. The 14 Kinders from Ms. Clark's class will go to the new teacher and each

kinder teacher will select 2-3 students to go to the new classroom. In the end, each kinder teacher will end up with 22 students. We will be notifying parents on Monday if your child is moving to the new classroom. The actual move will take place on Tuesday. We will try to make the move as painless as possible. Of course, smaller class size is what we know our students need to thrive and to receive the most academic support. The person that we select will be an outstanding and nurturing teacher.

\*Parents, I hope as many of you as possible will attend Coffee with Board Member Melvoin on Wednesday at 10:30am in Rm#19. He wants to reach out to the community to get to better know constituents.

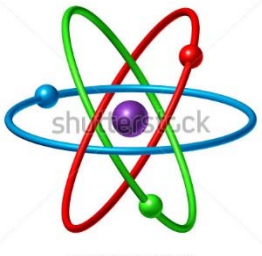
\*I want to thank Teresa Luu, Parent Liaison, for providing breakfast for Nestle teachers on Saturday.
