

Should you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact us. I have taken the liberty of providing answers to questions you may have.

- Monday, December 17 will be a regular Monday (7 period) schedule with a dismissal time of 2:50pm.
- Lunch will be served Tuesday - Thursday during the finals week.
- Teacher’s Assistants will need to attend the class in which they TA for the entire period.
- Students who have off-campus passes for employment will need to make adjustments to their work schedules to be present for their finals.
- To minimize distractions, students are not allowed to leave a class early if they finish a final.
- Students are not required to eat lunch. They may leave campus at 11:00am Tuesday–Thursday and 9:20a on Friday.
- Students who choose not to attend Rider Time will be asked to leave campus no later than 11:30am on Tuesday - Thursday and 9:40 on Friday. Parents should make arrangements to pick-up students at the appropriate time.
- Students who have on campus extra-curricular activities (athletics, band, clubs, etc) will not be allowed to hang out on campus during Rider Time. Students can return to campus after 2:00p to minimize distractions for those students who choose to attend Rider Time.
- Finals will take the form of exams, projects, or performance tasks.
