

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

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The Seaford Board of Education recognizes that a child's attendance in school each day is a fundamental condition for learning. Being present in the classroom enables the student to participate in instruction, class discussions, and other related activities that promote learning. As such, regular attendance and active involvement in classroom learning activities are integral to instilling incentives for the student to succeed.

The regular school attendance of children in the Seaford School District, while primarily the responsibility of the student's parents/guardians, is a shared responsibility among parents/guardians, school officials, the student, and the legal officers of the State.

In general, attendance is required of all students enrolled in Seaford School District schools. Beyond that, State attendance laws govern student attendance and are to be followed by all who share responsibility for student attendance in the schools of the Seaford School District.
