### Risk Control Grant

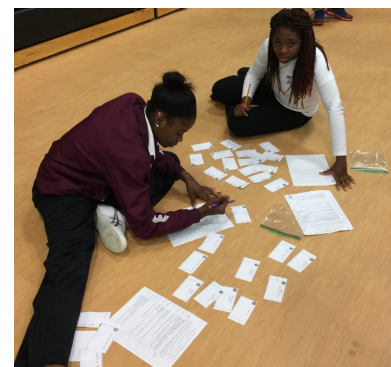
Hampton School District One is the recipient of a Risk Control Grant in the amount of \$10,285 through the South Carolina School Boards Insurance Trust. Funds will be used to 1) support online safety training for employees, 2) purchase a scissor lift for vertical maintenance tasks, and 3) repair broken and damaged sidewalks.



The purpose of the Risk Control Grant is to help protect the safety of employees, students and the public – while reducing the frequency and cost of claims.
