

PSCS Dress Code Policy

In keeping with District Policy, Public Service adopted a Dress Code Policy that is reasonably related to the health and safety of our students. All students shall be required to show proper attention to personal cleanliness, health, neatness, safety and suitability of clothing and appearance for school activities.

Simple guidelines for school-appropriate dress code are:

- Shoes must be worn at all times. Discretion should be used as to the appropriateness and safety of certain types of shoes. No house slippers or sandals may be worn.
- Tights, leggings or saggy jeans are **NOT** permitted. Ripped jeans must not be ripped between the belt line and the line where dress-code compliant shorts, skirts, or dresses would be (see below).
- Dresses, skirts or shorts may be no shorter than fingertip length.
- Excessively tight or baggy shirts are **NOT** permitted.
- Hoodies are **NOT** permitted inside any building.
 - Any head gear or accessories that promote drugs, alcohol or other restricted substances are **NOT** permitted.
 - Any items that promote sex, violence or gang activity are **NOT** permitted (determined at the discretion of faculty, staff, and administrators)
- Clothing that is suggestive, has a double meaning or innuendo, or suggests inappropriate ideas is unacceptable.
- Clothing and accessories that display initials, promote drugs, alcohol, sex, violence or gang activity are **NOT** permitted.
- Halter-tops, bare midriff, see-through apparel are not to be worn.

PSCS students must have their PSCS lanyards/IDs on and visible the entire school day!
