Plans made by the School Community Council are submitted to and approved by the Jordan School District School Board, as well as the Utah State Board of Education.

Qualifications

To serve on the School Community Council, you must be either an employee of Copper Hills High School or a parent who has or will have a student attending the school during one of your first two years on the Council. School employee members are generally selected by school employees. Parents are elected by fellow parents of students attending the school. Membership terms are for two years. If needed, elections are held at the beginning of each school year. Members who are elected to the Council then select officers in the initial meeting on Wednesday, September 18, 2019 at 6:00pm in the Copper Hills High School Media Center.
