# <u>Visuals</u>


On projector show pictures of Dandelion paintings

### <u>Lesson</u>

Many famous artists painted flowers and landscapes.


### **Start Project**

- 1. Place your 9x12 light blue construction paper in portrait position. (Show students the difference between portrait and landscape)
- 2. With green marker draw the stem of the dandelion. (students may choose to draw 1-3 stems)
- 3. At the top of the stem draw a small ball
- 4. Draw a few lines through the ball
- 5. With a Q-Tip dip into the white paint to make the flower
- 6. After dandelions are completed have students sign project
- 7. Collect finished project and pre-pair for the next project.



#### Clean Up

Clean all the paint brushes and store them bristles up so they do not bend while drying. Restock the bin and return bin and art supplies to art room.
