

Materials Needed in 8th Grade

- Students will need supplies **both** here **at school** and available **at home** for their core classes (language arts, math, science and social studies).
- *The students should have available at home:* colored pencils, glue, ruler, lined paper, pencils, and a scientific calculator.
 - *The students should have available here at school:* **LOTS OF PENCILS**, erasers, handheld pencil sharpener, colored pencils, and markers. They will use them in all of their **CORE** classes.
- **Science:** Binder or Folder, dry erase markers, sanitizing wipes and lots of pencils:)
- **English:** a pocket folder or three ring binder, colored pencils, pencils or pens (we do daily writing).
- **History** one folder (just for History), set of 8 markers / colored pencils, pencil top erasers, glue sticks and enough pencils to last the school year. Last names A-J: 1 container of Lysol Wipes. Last names K-T: Kleenexes. Last names U-Z: 1 BIG glue stick.
- **Math :** Scientific calculator (recommended models are the TI-34 (or above) or Casio's fx-300ms - (for home), 1 1/2 inch or 2 inch 3-ring binder (just for **MATH**), a ruler with both inch and centimeter markings (for home).

*Please note that this list is not exclusive and additional materials may be necessary, including materials for exploratory classes.

Because many classes require a separate binder, we do not recommend a trapper keeper.
