

NMS 2019-2020 School Improvement Goals

Goal #1

- A. During the 2019-2020 school year, NMS will decrease the percentage of students in Grades 6-8 scoring a level 1 in ELA by 5% points:**
- 6th grade ELA from 43% on the Spring 2019 ELA GMAS to 38% on the Spring 2020 ELA GMAS
 - 7th grade ELA from 39% on the Spring 2019 ELA GMAS to 34% on the Spring 2020 ELA GMAS
 - 8th grade ELA from 44% on the Spring 2019 ELA GMAS to 39% on the Spring 2020 ELA GMAS
- B. During the 2019-2020 school year, NMS will increase the percentage of students in Grades 6-8 scoring in level 3 and above in ELA by 5% points**
- 6th grade ELA from 20% on the Spring 2019 ELA GMAS to 25% on the Spring 2020 ELA GMAS
 - 7th grade ELA from 22% on the Spring 2019 ELA GMAS to 27% on the Spring 2020 ELA GMAS
 - 8th grade ELA from 14.6% on the Spring 2019 ELA GMAS to 19.6% on the Spring 2020 ELA GMAS
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Goal #2

- A. During the 2019-2020 school year, NMS will decrease the percentage of students in Grades 6-8 scoring a level 1 in Math by 5% points:**
- 6th grade Math from 48% on the Spring 2019 Math GMAS to 43% on the Spring 2020 Math GMAS
 - 7th grade Math from 40% on the Spring 2019 Math GMAS to 35% on the Spring 2020 Math GMAS
 - 8th grade Math from 52% on the Spring 2019 Math GMAS to 47% on the Spring 2020 Math GMAS
- B. During the 2019-2020 school year, NMS will increase the percentage of students in Grades 6-8 scoring in level 3 and above in Math by 5% points:**
- 6th grade Math from 10% on the Spring 2019 Math GMAS to 15% on the Spring 2020 Math GMAS
 - 7th grade Math from 25% on the Spring 2019 Math GMAS to 30% on the Spring 2020 Math GMAS
 - 8th grade Math from 7.7% on the Spring 2019 Math GMAS to 12.7% on the Spring 2020 Math GMAS

Goal #3

The number of discipline referrals will decrease by 5% for the 2019-2020 school year.
