Things to bring to APPFest 2.0:

- SAT and/or ACT Test scores**
- Test scores from Advanced Placement exams if you've taken them**
- Annual income (Your parents' if you're a dependent)**
- Social security number (Your Alien Registration Number, if you are not a U.S. citizen)**
- Citizenship status (including immigration status and visa type for those from outside the U.S.)**
- A professional personal email account. *You can obtain one with GMAIL or YAHOO***
- List of schools you are planning on attending**

For the FAFSA/Dream Act:

- Your parents' 2018 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned. (Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)**
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)**
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)**
- An FSA ID (for FAFSA applicants only) to sign electronically (fafsa.gov). Please create your FSA ID by November 11th to work on your FAFSA on 11/16.**
