

DEFINITION OF “SIBLING”

The Academy for Classical Education defines a sibling as follows:

- Children who share at least one common biological or legal parent whether through natural or adoptive means. This includes:
 - Biological siblings that share parents;
 - “Half” siblings that share a single parent;
 - “Step” siblings that share a parent or parents through marriage; and
 - Children who share a parent or parents through adoption or guardianship.

Children who live in the same household but do not share a biological or legal parent are NOT considered a sibling and will not be granted sibling priority.
