Traditional Schedule

Students have no control over their daily schedules.

Homework must be completed outside of the scheduled school/class time.

Students rush from one class to another with little time to rest and process their learning.

Lunch is only 30 minutes long. Studying, and club and group business all happens during this time.

Collecting and completing makeup work must be done outside of class.

Group work must be completed during instruction time, during lunch or outside of school hours.

Flex Mod Schedule

Students have choice for certain parts of their daily schedules.

Homework can be completed during Flex Mod periods.

Students can rest, process, collaborate and learn on a deeper level during Flex Mods.

Lunch is extended to 48 minutes. More time is provided to allow students to eat and participate.

Collecting and completing makeup work can be done during the school day in a Flex Mod.

Group work can be completed during Flex Mod periods, during specific group work class time, and with a variety of peers.

Our new Flexible Modular schedule was designed to better support not only the academic needs of our students, but also their social and emotional needs.

The ultimate goal is to customize learning for students so all needs are met. We want students to get remediation, enrichment or explore passions during the school day while at Robert G. Cole.
