On June 8, 2008, Army Corporal Kevin McCloskey was driving in a convoy with the 506th Infantry Regiment (4th Brigade), 101st Airborne Division in Logar Province, Afghanistan when his vehicle struck an improvised explosive device (IED). The explosion resulted in the loss of both his legs, vision loss in his right eye, burns, and traumatic brain injury (TBI).

Now medically retired, Kevin enjoys spending time with his wife Bridget. An avid golfer, Kevin helps others with injuries play the sport through the Eastern Amputee Golf Association's First Swing clinics. He says living in a specially adapted, custom home will allow him to dedicate more time pursuing his passion and helping others.
