

Bylaws of the Board

Attorney

Legal Counsel

The Board may appoint a legal counsel to perform any of the following duties:

1. Render legal advice to the Superintendent, Board and employees of the district.
2. Serve the Superintendent in the preparation and conduct of school district litigation and administrative proceedings.
3. Render advice on school bond and tax increase measures and prepare the necessary forms for the voting of these measures.
4. Other administrative duties as assigned by the Board and Superintendent.
