Food Services



Breakfast and lunch at school offers a wide variety of convenient, economic, and healthy alternatives. When your student joins us for breakfast and lunch you can rest assured that they are eating nutritious meals.

- **Your student may be eligible for Free or Reduced-price meals.** To participate in the program you must complete an application. Only one application is required for all children in the same household within Campbell High School District. All application information is confidential. Completing the application may help the school to earn money to pay for things like teachers, books and reduces the cost of your students AP test. You can contribute to your child's education simply by filling out this form!
- Applications will be mailed home two weeks before school begins. Applications are also available at the schools office or you can apply online at mylunchapp.CUHSD.org. Applications must be returned to the school office and will take 7 working days to process.
- If you qualified last school year your eligibility will carry over for the first 30 days of the current school year. You must turn in a new application to continue eligibility or your student will be required to pay for meals.
- Students need to bring money or parents can make payments online at mylunchpayments.CUHSD.org. Money remaining on the account at the end of the school year will be automatically rolled over to the next school year. Parents can request a refund in writing at any time.
- Students ID card are required to receive a meal. Students with negative balances will receive automatic phone calls and reminder letters. Students can charge only one breakfast and lunch per day.
- Meal prices for the year will be \$1.25 for breakfast and \$3.25 for lunch.
- The cafeteria employs students to work during break and lunch time. Students interested in job opportunities can apply online at studentworker.cuhsd.org.
