#### Registration Procedures

Parents / Guardians without internet access can complete the online portion at the district office.

Go to: [hampton1.org/registration](http://hampton1.org/registration)

Click Start and create a username and password.

Enter the student(s) information.

Create an appointment for final registration clearance.

Bring the following items to your appointment:

- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card (preferred not required)
- Immunization form (DHEC)
- Proof of Residency (one of the following)
  - Utility bill with physical address
  - Lease/rental agreement
  - Property tax receipt with physical home address
- School Transcript or Report Card
- Guardianship documents if not the parent.
- Parent / Guardian Driver's License or Identification

NOTE: Registration cannot continue without the birth certificate, proof of residency, and if applicable the guardianship documents.
