The Hoxie School Board met for its regular school board meeting on December 8, 2014 with all five members present. Minutes from the previous meeting was approved.

The board recognized the senior high volleyball team for the accomplishments they received during the 2014 season. Coach Goodwin introduced her players and stated that they had won third in the district and went on to represent our district in the state volleyball tournament. The superintendent also commended the junior high team for winning the conference title and being undefeated.

On a motion by Mr. Worlow, seconded by Mr. Romine, with a unanimous decision, the board approved the financial report as presented by Mr. Baker.

On a motion by Mr. Romine, seconded by Mr. Gates, with a unanimous decision, the board accepted the recommendation of the superintendent to approve the retirement of Jackie Fultner as custodian, effective at the end of December 2014.


Administrators Reports:


