DEFINITION:

Under the direction of the Principal the AFJRROTC Instructor teaches Aerospace Science as an integral academic course of study prescribed by the Air Force and conducted by the school.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Instructors are retired Air Force personnel certified by AFJRROTC.
2. Ability to recruit, motivate, select, retain, and commission qualified students through the AFJRROTC campus program.
3. Provide assistance in motivational activities to the AFJRROTC program and Civil Air Patrol programs.
4. Ability to work well with students, parents, staff, and community members.
5. Ability to perform in drills, parades, and ceremonies along with students.

CREDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must be a Commissioned Officer.

Must possess or provide proof of eligibility for the Designated Subjects California Credential authorizing service as an ROTC Instructor in public schools. Successful candidate will be required, once employed, to earn the English Language Authorization.
