Requirements & Admission Priorities Information for Subsidized Preschool Programs

Part-Day California State Preschool Program (CSPP):

Serves eligible 3 and 4-year-old children that are not enrolled in a Transitional Kindergarten Program.

Requirements:

- ◆ Family Income within California Department of Education (CDE) income ceiling or family has a child who is at risk of abuse, neglect or exploitation, foster or receiving child protective service through county welfare department.

Admission Priorities:

- 1) Child Protective Services or at-risk of abuse, neglect or exploitation, foster child.
- 2) 4 years old (by September 1)
- 3) 3 years old (by September 1)
- 4) 3 & 4 years old (by September 1) from families whose income exceeds the current income ceiling issued according with CDE by 15% or less of the adjusted monthly income. (Limited to 10% of total enrollment)
- 5) Over income exceptional needs child (must have IEP on file)

Full Day California State Preschool Program (CSPP):

Serves eligible 3 and 4-year-old children that are not enrolled in a Transitional Kindergarten Program.
Children enrolled in full day programs must have a need for services.

Requirements:

- ◆ Family Income within California Department of Education (CDE) income ceiling or family has a child who is at risk of abuse, neglect or exploitation, foster or receiving child protective service through county welfare department.
- ◆ Need criteria: Employed, Seeking Employment, Vocational Training, Educational Program, Seeking Permanent Housing, Incapacitated, CPS, At-Risk or Homeless.

Admission Priorities:

- 1) Child Protective Services or at-risk of abuse, neglect or exploitation, foster child.
- 2) 4 years old (by September 1)
- 3) 3 years old (by September 1)

Both programs provide:

- ◆ meals and snacks to students,.
- ◆ parent education, referrals to health and social services for families, and staff development opportunities.
