Physical, Mental and Environmental Demands:

Sitting, walking level surface, reaching, bending, use of both legs; wrist/arm motion, grasping/holding, use of both hands, regularly lift 1-15 lbs., occasional lift 26-40 lbs., regularly carry/push 1-15 lbs., occasionally carry/push 26-40 lbs.; color vision, near vision, use of both eyes, sense of smell, normal hearing, distinguish sounds in transmission, speaking.

Mental:

Occasional stress of emergencies, normal work standards stress, ability to work with interruption, reading, interpreting policy, memorize and recall objects, people, analyze problems and generate alternatives.

Working Conditions:

Occasional exposure to sun, occasional wetness, dust, occasional exposure to childhood disease.
