

On Holy Thursday, the youth choir will also participate in the procession from the church to the hall. (They did this last year.) Parents, please sit behind the choir and be ready to accompany your son/daughter in the procession.

Choir members are invited to participate in the Easter Vigil Mass at 8:00pm on March 31st. This is the single most important Mass of the liturgical year – and, by far, the longest! Because this Mass lasts 2 ½ - 3 hours, it is difficult for younger children to stay awake and, to be honest, to stay focused. We leave it up to parents to decide whether or not to have their child attend the Easter Vigil Mass.
