



Celebrating a Legacy of Leadership, Commitment and Care:

The Sister Mary Christopher Moore Endowed Scholarship

As provincial minister of the Felician Sisters' Our Lady of Hope Province, Sister Mary Christopher Moore is the leader of the nearly 600 Felician Sisters in North America. Sister Christopher previously served in a number of leadership roles at the former Felician province in Coraopolis, PA, including provincial minister, provincial secretary, and council member.

Over the course of three decades, Sister Christopher served as teacher and administrator in a number of Catholic schools. Her classroom career began in elementary school classrooms as a teacher of science, religion, and language arts. Sister Christopher went on to become the English Department Chair at Quigley High School in Baden, PA, followed by an 18-year tenure as Principal of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart High School. One of the pioneers of green building in the Pittsburgh area, Sister Christopher was a member of the six-person team that led the 155,000-square-foot green renovation of the Felician Sisters' Coraopolis, PA provincial house which won the designation of the first Gold LEED-certified building (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) within the Pittsburgh area. Sister Christopher holds a B.A. degree from La Roche College, and M.Ed. from the University of Pittsburgh.

In honor of Sister Christopher's enduring legacy of leadership, deep commitment to Catholic education, and care and concern for the welfare of young people, the Sister Mary Christopher Moore Endowed Scholarship was established in 2017.

THE SR. M. CHRISTOPHER MOORE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman who demonstrates a sincere desire to be known, transformed and inspired as a student at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart High School. In the 2018-2019 school year, the amount of the scholarship has been set at \$2,000*, and will be renewable in part or full throughout the student's tenure at OLSH.

**Annual award amount is based on OLSH endowment earnings for the prior year*

ELIGIBILITY/REQUIREMENTS

- Young women and young men entering OLSH as freshmen may apply
- Application for enrollment submitted to OLSH Admission Office
- Demonstrated significant financial need based on criteria set forth by OLSH (as determined by FACTS, OLSH's third party tuition and financial aid management system)
- Enthusiasm for enrolling and receiving a high school education at OLSH

SCHOLARSHIP RENEWABILITY CRITERIA

- Student must maintain a 3.0 (85%) grade point average in all academic courses, and an average conduct score of 90 points or higher, monitored at the end of each semester of study
