

Halloween Costume Rules 2019



- All costume preparations are to be completed at home (No dressing or applying of make-up or colored hairspray once students arrive at school)
- Costumes may not be demeaning to any ethnic group, race, religion, nationality, disability, gender or gender identity, sexual orientation, or individual (staff or student) at the school.
- Costumes may not show obscene materials, threats, or prohibited substances (drugs and alcohol).
- Costumes with shorts, skirts, or dresses must be of an appropriate length for school.
- Costumes must not impair a student's vision or movement.
- No weapons, toy weapons, or props replicating weapons are to be brought to school.
- No costumes are allowed that would completely hide the identity of the student.
- No masks or excessive face paint
- No baby bottles/bottles/pacifiers
- No gang-related costumes
- No exposed fronts or backs of costumes
- No profanity (threatening or violent words)
- No blood (or other simulated effects that make make oo hoodies!
