Profile of a PreAP Student:

Although enrollment in these courses is open, the following should be considered by students and parents/guardians when considering enrollment in these courses:

- PreAP courses are designed to challenge students and prepare them for advanced level coursework in high school and in college.
- Curriculum in PreAP courses often
 - is more rigorous
 - moves at a faster pace
 - requires independent learning
 - requires outside reading and work

 - have proven history of academic success in the subject area
 - possess interest in the subject area

6th Grade Fine Arts Elective Choice

Art

Do you love to draw? Are you interested in learning more about art history and techniques? In Art you will work independently on assignments, keeping a sketchbook for your original ideas. You will be required to do sketchbook assignments for homework. There is a \$15 fee for art supplies.

Band

Do you want to learn how to play a wind instrument like flute, oboe, bassoon, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, horn, trombone, euphonium, or tuba? How about percussion? Instrument fittings and informational meetings take place later in the semester. The majority of the instruments must be rented or purchased. You will be expected to practice daily at home. There are a few evening graded performances throughout the year.

Choir

Are you interested in learning to use your voice as an instrument? In Choir we will work together to learn to sing as an ensemble. You will have minimal fees required for uniform and supplies. There will be two graded performances each semester.

Orchestra

Do you want the opportunity to learn to play the violin, viola, cello or bass? You will have to practice outside of school and have "take home" assignments. The majority of instruments must be purchased or rented. There are evening graded performances throughout the year.
