Dear Parents:

The Monroe County School System will be using Raptor Technology Software, a visitor management system that helps track guests at our school to assist with providing and monitoring a safe environment for our faculty, staff, and students.

Upon entering the building, you will be asked to present a valid state-issued ID, which will be scanned into the system. Upon receipt of the ID information, Raptor will check the national database to identify potential threats to the security of the school. Individuals with an ID reading that is returned as clear of any threats will be provided a badge identifying the name of the visitor, as well as the date and time of their visit. Guests will return to the office to sign out and return their badge prior to exiting the building. After your initial visit to the school, when your ID is scanned for the first time, your name and information will be stored on file in the system and you will not be required to scan your ID for future visits.
