We will begin the following options for students beginning second semester:

- a. We will begin offering Advanced Placement (AP) Study Jams with our AP teachers this week, from 3:20 – 4:50 p.m. This opportunity will be available to AP students until AP testing in May.

To ensure our student safety, the expectation is students will remain the above mentioned option for the entire 1hour and 30 minutes.

Student safety is our primary concern and we also believe in the continuous improvement of our instructional practice, therefore the following policies have been put into place for the 2018-19 school year.

At the end of the school day, students who are not participating in an after school sport or enrolled in tutoring intervention, 7th period class, or AP Study Jams are expected to exit campus and be picked up by parent/guardian, no later than 3:30 p.m. If the student is a bus rider, then the student needs to be on the 3:15 p.m. bus. In addition, the Library closes at the end of the school day, therefore students will not be admitted to the Library without prior approval from Mrs. Brenz and the administration team.

Only student athletes or students participating in Math Intervention, 7th Period class, or AP Study Jam will be eligible to ride the 4:45 p.m. late bus.
