We are excited to introduce something new to North Lee, our House System! The purpose of this system is to create a positive and energetic learning environment for all of our students. The House System is a positive reinforcement structure that provides students the opportunity to practice good manners, kindness, respect and teamwork. While also giving staff the opportunity to model these important characteristics and reinforce them. We want to use this system to unite our school and encourage leadership qualities in all grade levels and all students.

Wondering how it works? Each student is randomly placed in one of four houses. Each house is a different name, color, and represents a different character quality (on the back). The whole school will participate in a competition to receive the most points. Points are given for excellent behavior, impressive grades, or anything our school staff warrants a point. Any staff member can give points at any time. For example, our custodian might receive help picking up trash. We will constantly be on the lookout to praise the good we see in all of our students. This system will only focus on the positive; there will be no points deducted for negative behavior. Our House System will begin when we return from Christmas Break.
