PRESIDENT - The president will serve as head of Student Council and will be in charge of leading our meetings. The president will also serve in various leadership roles throughout the year as needed, as well as attending other special events. The President will lead the Council, and will work in close conjunction with the Student Council Teacher Committee in order to plan and execute special events.

VICE PRESIDENT - The vice president will work closely with the president. The vice president will also serve in the absence of the president. The vice president will communicate to the school and head important events along side the president and the Student Council Teacher Committee.

SECRETARY - The secretary will be responsible for recording minutes for each Student Council meeting. This student will also be in charge of submitting a note to the teacher committee after every meeting. Typing skills are recommended. The Secretary may also lead the council in creating posters, flyers, and other print publications as needed for the Council.

TREASURER - The treasurer will be responsible for helping to coordinate the council budget (e.g. events, activities, etc). This will mean keeping track of the current budget and updating the budget after each function in which money is involved.
