

**Acceptable Clothing for NUT Pass days and Mission Days**

- 9/1 through 10/31 students may wear shorts on dress down days. They should be appropriate length. After 11/1, no shorts as this coincides with the uniform policy.
- Girls may always wear dresses or skirts, but the length should be appropriate.
- **Yoga pants are NOT permitted!**
- Sweatpants, joggers, jeans (minimal rips) and jeggings are permitted as long as they are not revealing. Wear a long shirt to cover if unsure.
- Tee shirts are permitted as long as the graphic is either a sports team, location or character. Offensive graphics are not permitted.
- Tank tops are not permitted for any student. Spaghetti straps are not permitted. Shirts and blouses should be covering their intended areas, so no open shoulder. No belly revealing garments.
- UGG's may be worn by any student on a dress down day. Flips flops and sandals are never permitted for safety reasons.
- Students may not wear boots to school as shoes unless it is a special day or if there is snow.

If students violate the dress code, they may have to call home for a change of clothes. Uniforms are always in style in our school.
