Dear Lennox School Community,

This morning, the Superintendent of the Los Angeles County Department of Education recommended that all Los Angeles County school districts close for students effective Monday, March 16, 2020 until March 27, 2020. We are following this recommendation and school will be cancelled **for students** during this period, giving us time to reassess the latest news and updates regarding COVID-19.

All staff will report to their work locations on Monday, March 16th to further discuss this temporary closure. **Importantly, there are still no known cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) on any Lennox School campuses.**

We are fortunate to have a two-week spring break coming up in early April. As everyone reports to work on Monday, March 16th this will allow teachers and staff to plan academic activities that students can complete during the upcoming spring break. In addition, we are preparing a plan to serve student meals and provide deep cleaning to all of our campuses. More details are forthcoming.

We will continue to closely monitor the situation and provide updates as information emerges. You can also find information and resources on our district website.

Schools are closing to promote responsible social distancing. We are asking that you do the same at home. With that in mind, please refrain from gathering in large groups.

Thank you for working with us to ensure our school communities remain healthy and safe.
