Reason for Appeal: The Governing Board asks that the appeal address the specific priority under which the parent/guardian believes the intra-district request should be granted (BP5116.1, AR5116.1):

- Any student enrolled in a district school designated by the California Department of Education as “persistently dangerous.” (20 USC 7912; 5 CCR 11992)
- Any student who is a victim of a violent crime while on school grounds. (20 USC 7912)
- Upon a finding, that special circumstances exist that might be harmful or dangerous to a district school that is at capacity and otherwise closed to transfers.
- To grant priority under these circumstances, the Superintendent or designee must have received either: (Education Code 35160.5)
 - a. A written statement from a representative of an appropriate state or local agency, such as a law enforcement official, social worker, or a properly licensed or registered professional, such as a psychiatrist, psychologist, or marriage and family therapist
 - b. A court order, including temporary restraining order and injunction
- Any sibling of a student already in attendance in that school.
- Any Student whose parent/guardian is assigned to that school as his/her primary place of employment.
