Tennessee School Health Screening Yearly Notification

ATTENTION: PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Free student health screenings will be conducted at your child's school throughout the **2018-2019** school year.

Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT), Tennessee Department of Health and various other trained volunteers will be assisting with screening. Data does not include any identifying information.

All information is private and confidential. We will be screening to determine if your child has a health risk that:

- Needs medical attention, and/or
- Might affect his/her classroom work.

The screenings that will be conducted are as follows:

Vision – Grades Pre K, K, 2, 4, 6, and 8.

Hearing – Grades Pre K, K, 2, 4, 6 and 8.

Blood Pressure – Grades K, 2, 4, 6, 8 and 9th

Height and Weight – Grades K, 2, 4, 6, 8, and 9th

After a review by the school nurse, a copy of the child's screening results will be sent home with your child.

If there is a need for further evaluation by a physician, a referral will be indicated. These screenings do not qualify as an examination and parents are encouraged to make sure your child has annual medical check-ups and bi-annual dental check-ups.
