

With many students at home because of COVID-19 mitigation measures, this is a quick reminder about the online educational resources the state makes available for all K-12 students.

Each local district and charter school has access to standards-aligned K-12 content from **Britannica**, **ProQuest** and **TeachingBooks** as part of a statewide contract coordinated by the California State Library and the Riverside County Office of Education.

Signing up to receive this online content provides the ability for students and teachers to remotely access Britannica, ProQuest and [Teachingbooks.net](#). However, districts have to provide staff and students the credentials to do so. You can check with your IT department to make sure this has happened.
