



Harvest Festival Rules and Permission

Saturday, October 26, 2019

The Thrall Community Education Foundation (TCEF) is proud to be hosting the 5th annual Harvest Festival. Harvest Festival is a long-standing tradition at Thrall ISD. Each year, the student body at each grade level (K-12) nominates a queen and king candidate from their grade. With the help of their classmates, these candidates raise funds by selling raffle tickets or collecting monetary donations. The candidates raising the highest amount are crowned Harvest Festival Queen and King at the coronation ceremony.

The rules governing Harvest Festival Queen/King Race are as follows:

1. There will be one Harvest Festival Queen and King for grades K-12. They will represent the class collecting the most monies through raffle ticket sales or money donations or a combination thereof.
2. Four Diamond Queens and Kings will be selected. They are the representatives from the classes with the next highest amount of monies collected behind the King and Queen.
3. The Queen candidate is voted on by the class. The King candidate may be voted on by the class or chosen by the Queen candidate according to the class tradition.
4. No siblings or family member (living in the same household) may compete against each other. We will leave it up to the family to decide which child may run as a candidate.
5. Students may not serve as a Queen or King candidate for 2 consecutive years.

Harvest Festival is Saturday, October 26, 2019 from 4pm to 9pm. Candidates are required to be present at the coronation ceremony the evening of October 26th. Each class will raise monies for their Queen and King candidates thru raffle ticket sales and/or money donations. If anyone would like to donate an item for the silent auction, it will be greatly appreciated; however, it will NOT count towards a Queen/King candidate total. Parents may volunteer to sell raffle tickets or collect money donations. All monies collected from raffle ticket sales or donations will be deposited into the Thrall Community Education Foundation account. TCEF funding priorities are student scholarships, classroom initiatives and professional development. TCEF offers all graduating Thrall ISD seniors up to a \$1,000 scholarship to be used for education beyond high school. ***Our fundraising success during Harvest Festival directly impacts our ability to fund student scholarships and teach grants each year. Please keep this important fact in mind when considering allowing your student to run for Harvest Festival candidate.***

Parent permission is required to be considered as a candidate. Please return the attached permission slip by 8am on Friday, September 13, 2019, as this is the day the candidates will be chosen. Queen candidates will be required to wear long or tea-length evening gowns at the coronation ceremony. King candidates will be required to wear suits or sport coats and ties. No jeans or tennis shoes.

More details outlining the rules and dates of fundraising activities are included on the back of this form.

Listed below are the dates and times when monetary donations and raffle tickets are due. TCEF Members will be on campus on the designated days to collect donations/raffle ticket sales.

- **Candidate Raffle tickets and Monetary Donations** are due on, or before **October 25, 2019 between 7:30-8:30am** in the Thrall ISD Administration Building. Money turned in after 8:30am will be accepted but will NOT count towards the candidate's total. Unsold raffle tickets should also be turned in at this time.
- **Raffle tickets** will be issued to students when the Request for Raffle Ticket Form has been returned to -TCEF. Parents/Guardians must sign for the number of raffle tickets issued. Raffle tickets will be sent home with the student designated on the form or contact a TCEF board member to make other delivery arrangements. Additional tickets will not be issued until the first set of tickets and money has been turned in to TCEF.
- **Non-Candidate raffle tickets** (sold and unsold) and money are due back to the high school/elementary office by the **end of school on Monday, October 21, 2019** for all individuals **EXCEPT** candidates. Raffle tickets and money turned in after the deadline will be accepted but will NOT count towards the candidate's total.

If your schedule cannot permit meeting at the times designated above, please contact a TCEF Member to arrange another time. **RAFFLE TICKETS AND MONEY DONATIONS TURNED IN LATE WILL BE ACCEPTED BUT WILL NOT COUNT TOWARDS THE CANDIDATE'S TOTAL.** Please make sure to communicate these deadlines to any individual(s) that will be helping you fundraise for your candidate.

Candidate/Parent Information Packets containing more details on how to collect and document donations will be sent home with candidates on Monday, September 16, 2019.
