TITLE Sanitation Truck Driver

GENERAL SUMMARY

This position's responsibilities include but may not be limited to collect refuse from school district sites on a regular schedule, helping to ensure safe and attractive school district grounds.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

1. Pick up refuse/cardboard from school collection sites, using Class A sanitation truck and deliver refuse to central transfer station.
2. Maintain regular collection schedule, making special pick-ups when required.
3. Complete required paperwork.
4. Perform daily maintenance on sanitation truck; request major repairs as needed.
5. Clean vehicle inside (cab and hopper) and out as needed for safety and appearance.
6. Keep all dumpsters in safe working order (e.g., grease/replace castors, replace lids as needed).
7. In the course of work, inspect school district grounds for safety hazards; report and/or correct as needed.
8. Assist the General Maintenance Technician in a variety of duties as assigned.
9. Assist with snow removal duties as needed.
10. Perform other job related duties as assigned by supervisor.

OTHER FUNCTIONS

REPORTING RELATIONSHIPS

This position reports to the Director of Facilities

MENTAL DEMANDS

Experiences multiple demands and multi-tasking. Requires concentration and attention to detail.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Requires prolonged standing, sitting, bending, stooping, crawling and other physical exertion; requires safety awareness on construction, repair and emergency sites; may be required to work during off-hours for emergencies; exposed to high noise levels from machines; may be exposed to potentially dangerous conditions; required to wear protective gear; required to work outdoors

in inclement weather; required to lift and carry heavy supplies, materials and equipment over one hundred (60) pounds; required to drive between sites.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Possess a high school diploma or equivalent.
2. Possess a valid Washington State Driver's License, with Class B CDL endorsement.
3. Two years truck/bus driving experience. At least, one year experience in the operation of a sanitation truck preferred.
4. Two years experience operating grounds equipment and other grounds work, including at least one year of heavy truck driving.
5. Have ability to respond to District needs on an "on-call" basis.
6. Possess good communications skills and the ability to work cooperatively and collaboratively with a variety of personalities in person, over the phone, and on the radio.
7. Ability to lift up to 60 pounds and to move large bins on wheels.
8. Ability to climb in and out of truck many times during the day and to walkabout on various types of terrain (e.g., grass, dirt, pavement).
9. Ability to work outdoors in all types of weather.
10. Ability to see and hear well enough to safely back and/or drive a large truck in areas with pedestrians (especially children).
8. Maintain appearance and conduct suitable for working with students, other district staff and the public.
9. Possess a current first aid card.
