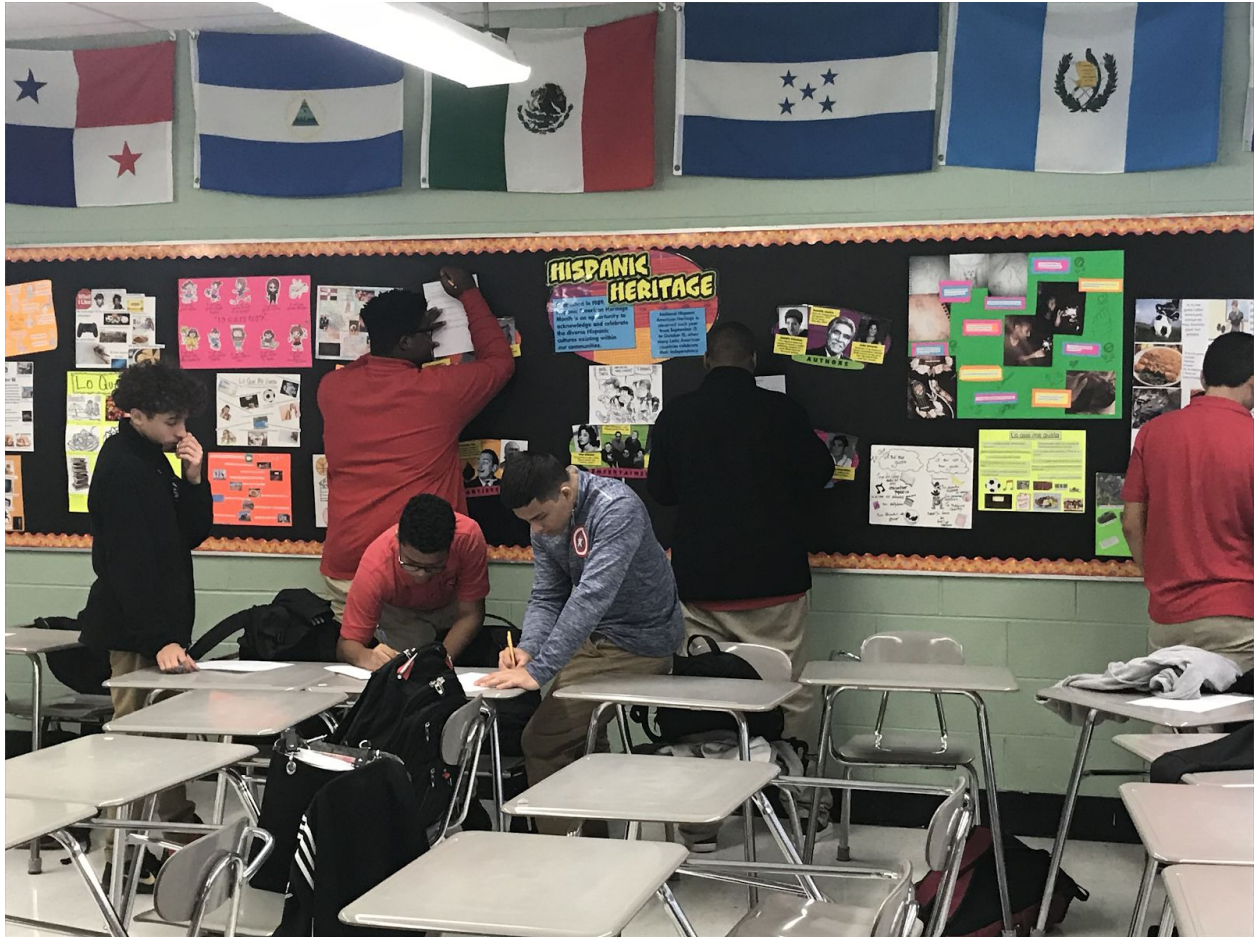


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Week of Respect in Full Effect! Room 205 Respect, Anti-Bullying and Tolerance Carousel Activity
