2018 - 2019 CLUBS AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students at Seitz Middle School have several opportunities to participate in after school clubs and extra-curricular activities. We are thankful for and appreciate the teachers who sponsor these clubs. The following is a list of clubs and activities available to Seitz students.

Club/Activity: Art Club

Sponsor(s): Mrs. English

Activities: Various art activities; decorating for holidays, creating props for school plays, etc.

Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, 8th graders; \$5.00 fee

Meeting Day: Wednesdays 3-4 p.m. (November - April)

Club/Activity: Book Club

Sponsor(s): Ms. Barnes

Activities: For students who already enjoy reading or for students who would like to learn to enjoy reading; it's a time together with others to learn about new books, discuss books and have fun doing it.

Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, 8th graders; attend meetings and read books.

Meeting Day: Usually every other week on Tuesday or Thursday 3-4 p.m.

Club/Activity: Computer Club

Sponsor(s): Mr. Grahl

Activities: Students work on assignments, play games, construct web pages, conduct research and practice typing skills.

Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, 8th graders

Meeting Day: Wednesday 3-4 p.m.

Club/Activity: Drama Club

Sponsor(s): Mr. Hoying

Activities: Students learn the art of acting, lighting, scenery construction, costume design and construction, make-up, possibly some singing and dancing (musical theater).

Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, 8th graders

Meeting Day: Once a week (December - March); rehearsals will increase to 4 days a week a month before the performance

Club/Activity: Eco-Hope Club

Sponsor(s): Mrs. Everingham

Activities: Students help make Seitz Green by recycling, energy conservation, etc.

Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, 8th graders

Meeting Day: Most Thursdays 3-4 p.m.

Activities: Students will participate in service activities and reward activities.
Requirements: To be determined.
Meeting Day: Once a month
- Club/Activity:** Diversity Club

Activities: This is a time for students to get together with others and discuss social situations they may deal with day to day, and to encourage positive decision-making in those situations.
Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, 8th graders; regular attendance at the meetings; participate in the discussions.
Meeting Day: Once a month
- Club/Activity:** Student Council

Activities: This is where the student elected representatives from each grade work together to raise funds for community and school projects. These fundraisers include Spirit Week, running the school store, sponsoring the Staff vs. Students game, etc.
Requirements: A student must be elected into office by his or her peers.
Meeting Day: The Council has monthly meetings with random committee meetings set up in between.

Activities: Students gather photos, information and create the yearbook.
Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, 8th graders; no more than five absences for the year.

Activities: Students will strive to produce the best edition of daily video news for all Seitz students.
Requirements: Open to all 7th and 8th grade students
Meeting Day: Every day, year round

Activities: Students explore engineering through fun-packed, high-energy, hands-on activities. They partner with a DSG club from a different country!
Requirements: Open to 6th grade students only
Meeting Day: Once a week for 12 weeks (runs twice during the school year)

Club/Activity: Future City

Sponsor(s): Ms. Farkas

Activities: The Future City engineering design competition starts with a question—how can we make the world a better place? To answer it, students imagine, research, design, and build cities of the future that showcase their solution to a citywide sustainability issue. The 2018-2019 theme is Powering Our Future! Teams will design a resilient power grid for their future city that can withstand and quickly recover from the impacts of a natural disaster.

Requirements: Open to all 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students (admittance is through application, since space is limited)

Meeting Day: Twice per week (October through January 29 competition at Suburban Collection Showplace.

Club/Activity: Robotics

Sponsor(s): Ms. Farkas

Activities: Seitz Middle school is the home of the Robobucs, two different robotics teams that bring technology and engineering together in one challenging and engaging activity! We participate in FIRST Robotics. FIRST Tech Challenge is a student-centered activity that focuses on giving students a unique and stimulating experience. Each year, teams participate in a new Game Theme that requires them to design, build, test, and program autonomous and driver-operated Robots that perform a series of tasks. Teams also immerse themselves as engineers and scientists, while keeping track of their work in their Engineering Log. This year, we will also have a Marketing and Community Outreach branch that will work to get the RoboBucs more involved outside of Seitz.
