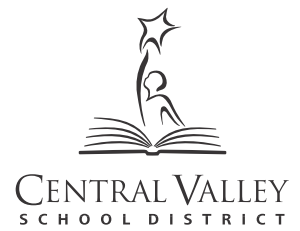


Kindergarten Registration

2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR



WELCOME! REGISTRATION BEGINS MARCH 2, 2020 AT 8:00 A.M.

Age – To enroll in kindergarten, your child must be five years old on or before August 31. Newly-enrolling first graders must be six years old on or before August 31, unless they have previously attended a public or accredited private kindergarten. **Proof of age** is required, such as a state-certified birth certificate (hospital-issued souvenir birth certificates are not accepted). Parents who feel their child may qualify for early entry should call 558-5500.

Immunizations – Proof of current vaccines is required by the WA State Department of Health. Parents must provide a *Certificate of Immunization Status* form signed by their health care provider. The registration process is not complete and classroom space cannot be held until all vaccines are up-to-date.

Residency – Due to limited classroom space, **proof of residence** (a current electric bill– Avista, Inland Power, Vera Power, etc.) is required at the time of registration. If an electric bill is not available, then a rental agreement, lease agreement, or buyer’s agreement will be temporarily accepted.

- Your student *may* be transported to another school if classroom space is not available due to larger than expected enrollment. Students are enrolled on a first-come, first-served basis.

School Choice (Transfer) – CVSD students may apply to attend a school outside their boundary area on a space-available basis. Due to limited space for the 2020-21 school year, all elementary schools, except Progress, will most likely not have space available for transfer. View boundary information at www.cvsd.org.

Transportation – Bus transportation is available for all students residing outside a one-mile radius from their school. Bus route information may be furnished by your school prior to the start of the school year and is also available online at www.cvsd.org.

Meals – Breakfast is available to all children. Children may also participate in the lunch program or bring a lunch from home.

Special Education – Kindergarten students who qualify for special education services will be served in a way that will best meet their learning needs. Call 558-5500 for more information.

Classroom Placement – Prior to the start of school, families will receive information directly from their school about classroom placement and back-to-school activities.

Schedule – MTWF: 9am-3:15pm; Thursdays: 10am-3:15pm

Start Date – Full-day Kindergarten will start September 14. The first 3 days (Sept. 9-11) are for parent-teacher meetings for the State WA Kids requirements. After enrollment, a welcome letter from the school will be mailed to you.
