

2018-19 WHS Exemption Procedures
Addendum to Page 60 of the Student Handbook

Woodsboro high school students meeting all the following criterion will be eligible to exempt midterm and/or final exams for the 2018-19 school year.

NOTE: Earning an exemption from an exam does not exempt a student from attending school on the day of the exam. State law requires students to be in attendance on all scheduled school days based on the District's school calendar.

Criterion

1. Student has spent **NO TIME in DAEP or ISS** for the school year.
2. Student has **NO UNEXCUSED** absences beginning Monday, September 17, 2018 for exams in December 2018 and Wednesday, January 9, 2019 for exams in May 2019.
3. Student has the following grade to attendance relationship for the semester one week prior to exams.
 - a. A semester average of a 90 or greater and no more than three absences.
 - b. A semester average of 80 - 89 and no more than two absences.
 - c. A semester average of 75 - 79 and no more than one absence.

An exemption form will be provided by the office to all students meeting criterion one and two. Teachers will then need to complete the grade to absence section for their specific course. Students will be responsible for returning the form to the office completed and signed by all necessary people no later than the Monday of exam week.
