AP Exam registration will be done online at www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/51015. There is a chart listed below with the fee schedule. The registration window will be from January 28 through February 22, 2019. There will be a late charge fee of \$10 per test starting on February 23 until March 4, 2019. Payment must be made in full by **March 4th**. The school will not be accepting payments. No exams may be ordered after this March 4th!!!

- (1) meet the *Income Eligibility Guidelines* shown below,
- (2) provide documentation of Income Eligibility (see below).
- (3) See Mr. Lopez in the main office to verify Eligibility

II. The student qualifies for the AP Test Fee Program if:

Household income does not exceed 185 percent of the federal poverty income guidelines (see table below). Annual gross or total income level is used to determine eligibility (if you are using a U.S. Individual Income Tax Return Form 1040, refer to line 22; line 15 on the 1040A; and line 6 on the 1040EZ). III. Verification of Need – Family or Student (18 years or older, not a dependent)

To verify that you qualify for the AP Test Fee Program, you must either:

- Qualify for the Free & Reduced Price Meal program (school can verify this without documentation)
- Provide one of the following forms of documentation:
 - Verification from another governmental source.
 - A signed financial aid application.
 - A signed United States or Puerto Rico income tax return.
 - A Parental (Student) Financial Hardship Statement.
