The Requirements

- Each student must register online at <https://www.norwalkpl.org/1011/2019-Summer-Game> and track their reading and reading-related activities. *Note that you do not need a library card to participate, and you can register digitally, so you do not need to physically visit the library.
- Each student must record a minimum of **three books** and complete **one challenge activity**.
- Each student must bring a **printed copy of their finished log** sheet to school on the **first day**.

Also on the Norwalk Library website are [suggested book lists by grade level](#). The [Nutmeg Books](#) are also a good resource, especially for students in the upper grades. We encourage students to challenge themselves to read beyond the minimum and to read books out of their preferred genre.

It can also be beneficial to visit the library. Librarians are an invaluable resource when it comes to helping children select books, and the library offers a number of fun and free programs.
