Holy Rosary School School Volunteer Guidelines

Volunteers serving in the school will support and model the moral teachings of the Catholic Church and function faithfully within the mission and structures of the school, parish, and Diocese with proper respect for those serving in ministries.

Volunteers work in a collaborative role with others ministering to the development of the children and the school as an educational institution. Volunteers are asked to recognize confidentiality as a living principle and respect the dignity of those with who they work and come into contact.

Volunteers accept responsibility to use contacts made through the school in such a way so as not to disrupt the peace, order and tranquility of the school community.

Should volunteers come into conflict on school/parish related issues, it is the responsibility of both to resolve the dispute through personal diplomacy and/or an executive decision by the school Principal and/or the Pastor of the parish.

Any person who has a conflict with a school/parish volunteer outside of the boundaries of the school/parish activities must settle that dispute outside of and without involving or using school/parish resources.

Holy Rosary School believes that student dress affects student behavior and, as such, believes that modeling by volunteers affects students, as well. We at Holy Rosary School ask that volunteers at school or chaperoning on a field trip do not wear:

- Backless, strapless, spaghetti strap or tank tops.
- Shirts with inappropriate wording or graphics.
- Pants should fit comfortably with no writing on the seat of the pants.
- Walking shorts may be worn, yet no shorter than 2-3 inches above the knee.
- Shoes should be comfortable for walking.

Most importantly that:

- Modesty and main line dressing be the model at all times.

Also, please remember:

- Appropriate use of cell phone as we are to be present to our students that are in our care.
- No smoking.
- No alcohol.
