



To Parents/Guardians of Blue Peak High School Students:

It is time to start registration for all students. Online registration will be required for ALL Tooele County School District students K-12 for the 2018-2019 school year.

On-line registration is now available. If you do not have access to a computer at home, you may register on a computer at Blue Peak High School (BPHS). Our registration date is:

- **August 14th (9:00 am - 2:00 pm).** Counselors will be available on this day.

Registration:

- Follow the instructions. If you need assistance please contact helpdesk@tooeleschools.org or call 435.833.8761.
- Print a copy of your completion certificate. Blue Peak High School is not set up to accept on-line (My School Fees) payments. Please bring the completed copy of your student's registration, payment for fees, (cash or check or credit/debit card) on August 14th from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm. Options for paying school fees are listed below.

Options for paying school fees:

1. Pay fees in person:

- Bring a printed copy of your completion certificate
- Pay your school fees. We accept cash, debit/credit cards and checks (made payable to Blue Peak High School).
- Blue Peak High School is not currently set up to pay fees on line.

2. Apply for a fee waiver YOU MUST COMPLETE A NEW FEE WAIVER APPLICATION EACH YEAR!!!

- A copy of the fee waiver application is available online, or at the school. You may start the **fee waiver application online**; however you must print the forms and bring them with you to the school.
- Please bring a **COPY** of any required support documentation. The documentation needed is listed below. If applying is based on:
 - Income - Copies of your last three pay stubs and/or most recent Income Tax Return.
 - SSI for blind or disabled children -A copy of a STUDENT'S Supplemental Security Income Benefit Verification Letter. *Students who receive Survivor Benefits do not qualify for the SSI category.
 - AFDC support -A copy of your AFDC Letter of Decision showing you are currently qualified for financial assistance or food stamps. No Horizon cards will be accepted as proof of qualification.
 - Foster Care or State Custody - A copy of the "Youth in Custody Required Intake Form" and/or "School Enrollment Letter."

3. Delayed payment

- Complete the delayed fee payment agreement and return to the finance department at Blue Peak High School.

We hope these choices will make registration easy and convenient for you and your student.
