Course Description: This course is designed for students who received a D or F in a Science and need to re-take one or both semesters to improve their grade and either meet the graduation requirement for Science.

Credit: 5 credits each semester

For remedial students, successful completion of 1st and/or 2nd semester with grades of C or better will improve the student's GPA and will make the student eligible for Science.

For advancement, completion of 1st and 2nd semesters of Science Summer School will make the student eligible for Science.

Dates & Times: Monday – Friday; 8:00 am –12:00 pm. (3 weeks a semester)

Semester 1: June 25th – July 13th

Semester 2: July 16th – August 3rd
