WHAT IS THE BOOST PROGRAM?

The Lexington County School District 3 BOOST program is designed to engage families with 2- and 3-year-olds in a Montessori learning environment, and is an interactive classroom setting for parent and child.

Children will experience exciting opportunities with Montessori materials, develop focus and concentration, improve motor skills and cognitive development, while preparing them for kindergarten readiness and a positive school experience.

Our BOOST Montessori sessions will begin on September 9, 2019, with additional sessions beginning in January. We will offer a choice of a Monday/Wednesday schedule or a Tuesday/Thursday schedule, both from 8:30 to 10:30 AM, for a total of eight weeks each. Additional BOOST enrollment sessions will take place after winter break, allowing new families to enroll in the program.

Parents will develop new knowledge of Montessori and their child's learning environment. Additionally, they will learn about early brain development, and be introduced to the importance of language and literacy.

This is not a drop-off childcare program or mother's morning out program. Spaces are limited, and there will be a waiting list for the next sessions.

WHY MONTESSORI?

Dr. Maria Montessori believed that no human being is educated by another, and felt as though the goal of early childhood education should be to cultivate the child's own natural desire to learn. She once quoted, "Never help a child with a task at which he feels he can succeed."

In the BOOST Montessori classroom, children will experience the excitement of learning by making their own choices, rather than being expected to participate in adult-directed activities. Much of the work offered in the BOOST program will highlight self-help skills that foster pride and independence. Children will have opportunities to practice practical life activities, work with materials that involve their senses, and be immersed in a rich language environment. This curriculum allows children to develop self-confidence and valuable problem-solving skills, while expanding their vocabulary development.

Montessori classrooms foster a love for learning and respect for the environment. Children will develop appropriate social skills, good manners, and consideration for others.
