Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

As you are aware the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has established a Homeland Security Advisory System to identify the various levels of risk for terrorist attacks. Attached is a description of the different levels of the Advisory System for you to review and understand. Further information regarding the Homeland Security Advisory System may be obtained by going to the website for the Department of Homeland Security at www.dhs.gov.

Your student is scheduled to leave the country on a school-sponsored trip. The NHUHSD feels that it is imperative that you as the parent(s)/guardian understand that there may be risk involved in the travel associated with the school sponsored activity. While every effort will be made to provide your student with a safe, educational experience, there are factors that are naturally beyond the control of the instructor, administrator or District.

The NHUHSD is requiring that the parent(s) or guardian of each student traveling outside of the United States for a school sponsored activity acknowledge that they are aware of the risks involved with this type of activity. Please sign and return this form to the school. All students will be required to have this form, forms JPA-1 and JPA-1(a) signed and on file at the school before departing on an out-of-country school sponsored activity. If you have any questions regarding this information, please contact your school principal.

I am aware that there are risks that are beyond my control of the school personnel that will be accompanying my student on the trip. While fully understanding these risks, I give my student, _____, my permission to take part in the school sponsored activity. I understand that the Northern Humboldt Union High School District retains the right to cancel any student trip when it is in the best interest of the students and the district. I further understand that the district will not be held fiscally liable if it determines that the trip need to be cancelled.
