Dear Nanaikapono Elementary School Parents and Guardians,

We have been made aware of an alleged threat to Nanakuli High and Intermediate School's campus on social media. The Honolulu Police Department and Federal Bureau of Investigation were contacted immediately and are investigating.

The safety of your child is of utmost importance. Additional department security and police officers were present on the Nanakuli High and Intermediate School campus throughout the day.

All threats to any of our schools and students are taken seriously and investigated thoroughly. Terroristic threats are considered Class A student conduct offenses. Penalties can range from detention to dismissal with the possibility of arrest and serious criminal charges.

We encourage parents to speak with their child(ren) about making the right choices and the potential consequences of their actions. I urge all students and families to refrain from reposting threats and/or rumors online. According to law enforcement, reposting a threat is as good as making the threat itself and contributes to prolonging the event.
