Mr. Jenkins called the meeting to order and Mr. Strother gave the invocation.

In accordance with the SC Code of Laws, 1976, Section 30-4-80 (d), as amended, the media has been notified of the time, date and place of this meeting (WBHC Radio Station and the Hampton County Guardian). In addition, the official agenda has been posted at the District Office.

Mr. Jenkins welcomed the public to the board meeting. There was no media present.

There was no unfinished business.

New Business

Mrs. Priester moved to proceed with the application for the Technology/Device Pilot Program as presented. Mrs. Murdaugh seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.

The Board discussed the possibility of changing the cost for out-of-district tuition for families with multiple children, but no change was made.

The results of the Career & Technology Survey were reviewed and it was decided that further discussions with students and parents were needed before vocational programs are expanded.

The new hires will be discussed in executive session.

Superintendent's Report

It was noted that the original location for installation of a water line to service shrubbery at NDMS would have to be modified due to the proximity of a water hydrant.

The storage building and bathrooms at the Wade Hampton track have been torn down and the Building Construction class will build a storage building at that location.

The press box at the Wade Hampton football field has been repaired.

\$1 million has been borrowed from our Tax Anticipation note, with approximately \$850,000 of that amount remaining in our fund balance.

Mrs. Murdaugh moved to enter into executive session to discuss a student discipline matter, personnel matter, and a legal issue. Mr. Strother seconded the motion. The motion was adopted unanimously.

The Board reconvened in Open Session.
